Faversham Creek Trust Charitable Objects

As contained in the Memorandum and Articles of Association. Adopted by the Board or Trustee/Directors on 9th March 2012 and registered with Charity Commission and Companies House

- 1) The promotion for the benefit of the public of urban or rural regeneration in areas of social and economic deprivation (and in particular in the Faversham Creek area) by **all** or **any** of the following means:
 - (a) the relief of financial hardship:
 - (b) the relief of unemployment:
 - (c) the advancement of education, training or retraining, particularly among unemployed people, and providing unemployed people with work experience:
 - (d) the maintenance, improvement or provision of public amenities:
 - (e) the preservation of buildings or sites of historic or architectural importance:
 - (f) the provision of recreational facilities for the public at large or those who by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, financial hardship or social and economic circumstances, have need of such facilities:
 - (g) the protection or conservation of the environment.
- (2) the advancement of education of the public on the subject of Faversham Creek Maritime history, heritage and boatbuilding tradition through delivering an ongoing programme of talks, presentations and study events.
- (3) Such charitable purposes for the public benefit as are exclusively charitable according to the laws of England and Wales as the trustees may from time to time determine.'
